You must provide sufficient evidence in your request to show that the required improvements have been made (i.e. documents, photographs).

An Officer will contact you prior to the re-visit to discuss these improvements.

We will make an unannounced visit within three months of receipt of the request.

You will receive a 'new' food hygiene rating based on the level of compliance that is found at the time of the revisit. You should be aware that your rating could go up, down or remain the same.
