East Lindsey District Council hereby give notice, in accordance with the provisions of regulation 5(5) of The Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017, that the development referred to in Part I hereof is unlikely to have significant effects on the environment. The Council has therefore adopted a screening opinion to the effect the development is not EIA development. The Council's reasons for reaching this conclusion are set out in the statement below.

1. The site is a green space in the middle of the village of Belchford within the Lincolnshire Wolds AONB. The site is associated with the Blue Bell Inn to the west but the land is otherwise surrounded by residential properties. The application has the potential to impact upon the protected landscape but the surrounding sites would limit any impact to within the village only and does not have to potential to have substantial impacts upon the wider protected landscape. The proposal would therefore not be EIA development and no environmental statement is required.
