WHEREAS the Council of the District of East Lindsey being the appropriate Local Planning Authority within the meaning of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1988 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") are satisfied that it is expedient that development of all or any of the descriptions set out in Schedule I hereto should not be carried out in those parts of the Louth Conservation Area listed in Schedule II hereto and more particularly shown coloured red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Order

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Order hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to the development of the descriptions set out in Schedule I hereto in those parts of the Louth Conservation Area listed in Schedule II hereto and more particularly shown coloured red on the said plan

## SCHEDULE I

- 1. Any change to the materials of which the roof of a dwellinghouse is constructed being development comprised within Part I Class B and/or Class C referred to in the Second Schedule of the Order and not being development comprised within any other Class
- 2. Any change to the appearance type size and materials of any window or external door which forms part of the dwellinghouse being development comprised within Part 1 Class A referred to in the Second Schedule of the Order and not being development comprised within any other Class
- 3. The erection or construction of a porch outside an external door of a dwellinghouse being development comprised within Part 1 Class D referred to in the Second Schedule of the Order and not being Development comprised within any other Class
- 4. The erection construction maintenance improvement or alteration of any wall or fence adjacent to a public highway or public right of way being development comprised within Part 2 Class A referred to in the Second Schedule 2 of the Order and not being development comprised within any other Class
