



Caravan Security Tips

KEEP YOUR CARAVAN SAFE IN THE SUMMER PERIOD

1. If leaving your van for a number of days/weeks **remove electronic goods from sight**.
2. **Leave curtains open**, so people can see there is nothing to steal.
3. If possible **set a light on timer switches** to periodically switch on.
4. **Fill in your registration pack** with details of make/model/serial numbers of valuable items.
5. **Mark your goods** with a UV pen or similar.
6. **Don't leave handbags, car keys or other items of value by open windows**, especially when you go to bed at night. Anyone can reach in and remove them.
7. **Lock your doors and windows** when you leave.
8. **Communicate with neighbours and your office** if you are leaving your caravan for a period of time.
9. **If you have an alarm, set it every time you leave** your holiday home.
10. **Don't leave bikes outside** or in outdoor sheds, they will be safer inside your caravan.
