Top 10 Tips

1. Remove all valuables from your caravan, especially flat screen TVs - games consuls & DVD players. Do not be tempted to leave them under the bed, or in a cupboard, thieves will find them.
2. Leave all curtains open & remove net curtains. Make it clear to would be thieves, there is nothing worth stealing
3. Leave cupboard doors open, so it is obvious there is nothing in them.
3. Ensure that all your contact details are up to date at the site office.
4. Place valuables removed signs on your caravan windows.
5. Ensure all your windows are locked & if possible cable tie the handles.
6. Remove all valuable equipment from your sheds, especially fishing equipment & bikes. Consider leaving these unlocked, so would be thieves can see there is nothing in, without damaging anything to find out
7. Wipe down all surfaces and windows, Police then know any fingerprints are new
8. Leave a sheet of paper inside the doorways, when you finally lock up. Footprints on the paper can be used to help trace offenders
9. Use a UV pen to mark any property left behind. If Police can prove its yours, they have more chance at prosecuting those now in possession of it.
