ORDER 2015

East Lindsey District Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Lincolnshire County Council in accordance with section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and in compliance with regulations made under the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall be cited as the East Lindsey District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Consolidation) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2015 and shall come into operation on 9 March 2015.
2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, words shall have the meanings assigned to them under Article 3 of the East Lindsey District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Consolidation Order) 2014
3. The East Lindsey District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Consolidation Order) 2014 (hereinafter called "the Order") shall be varied to the following extent:
 - (a) by varying the class of Vehicles (shown in column (2) of the Schedule to the Order) permitted to use those Parking Places detailed in the first column of the table at Part I below as shown in **bold type** in the third column of the table at Part I below; and
 - (b) by varying Article 9 so that existing Article 9 is renumbered Article 9.1 and a new Article 9.2 is added as follows:

"Where in column 2 of the Schedule reference is made to Motor Homes and unpowered vehicles exceeding 2.05 metres in height not being permitted on a Parking Place no person shall cause or permit such a Motor Home or unpowered vehicle to be brought into or parked within the Parking Place" ; and
 - (c) by varying Article 52 so that it reads as follows:

"Save for the provisions in Part VII, if a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place without complying with the requirements of this Order, or if a Vehicle or Motor Home which exceeds 2.05 metres in height or an unpowered vehicle drawn or designed to be drawn by a Vehicle (including but not limited to a caravan or a Trailer) which exceeds 2.05 metres in height is brought into a Parking Place where such Vehicles or Motor Homes or unpowered vehicles are not permitted, a contravention shall have occurred and a Penalty Charge shall be payable"; and

- (d) by varying the scale of parking charges payable for those Parking Places detailed in the table at Part II below as shown in **bold type** in the third column of the table at Part II below (and for the avoidance of doubt any existing charges and fees detailed in the Schedule to the Order which are not referred to in the second column of the table at Part II below shall remain as existing); and
- (e) by varying the areas of land included within the following Parking Places:
 - (i) Princes Parade, Skegness (numbered (2) in the Schedule to the Order). The existing extent of the Princes Parade, Skegness Parking Place is shown edged red on the attached Plan 1. The amended extent of the Princes Parade, Skegness Parking Place is shown edged red on the attached Plan 2
 - (ii) High Street/Silver Street, Coningsby (numbered (54) in the Schedule to the Order). The existing extent of the High Street/Silver Street, Coningsby Parking Place is shown edged red on the attached Plan 3. The amended extent of the High Street/Silver Street, Coningsby Parking Place is shown edged red on the attached Plan 4
- (f) by varying all references to the "Road Traffic Act 1984" contained within the Schedule to the Order so as to refer instead to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

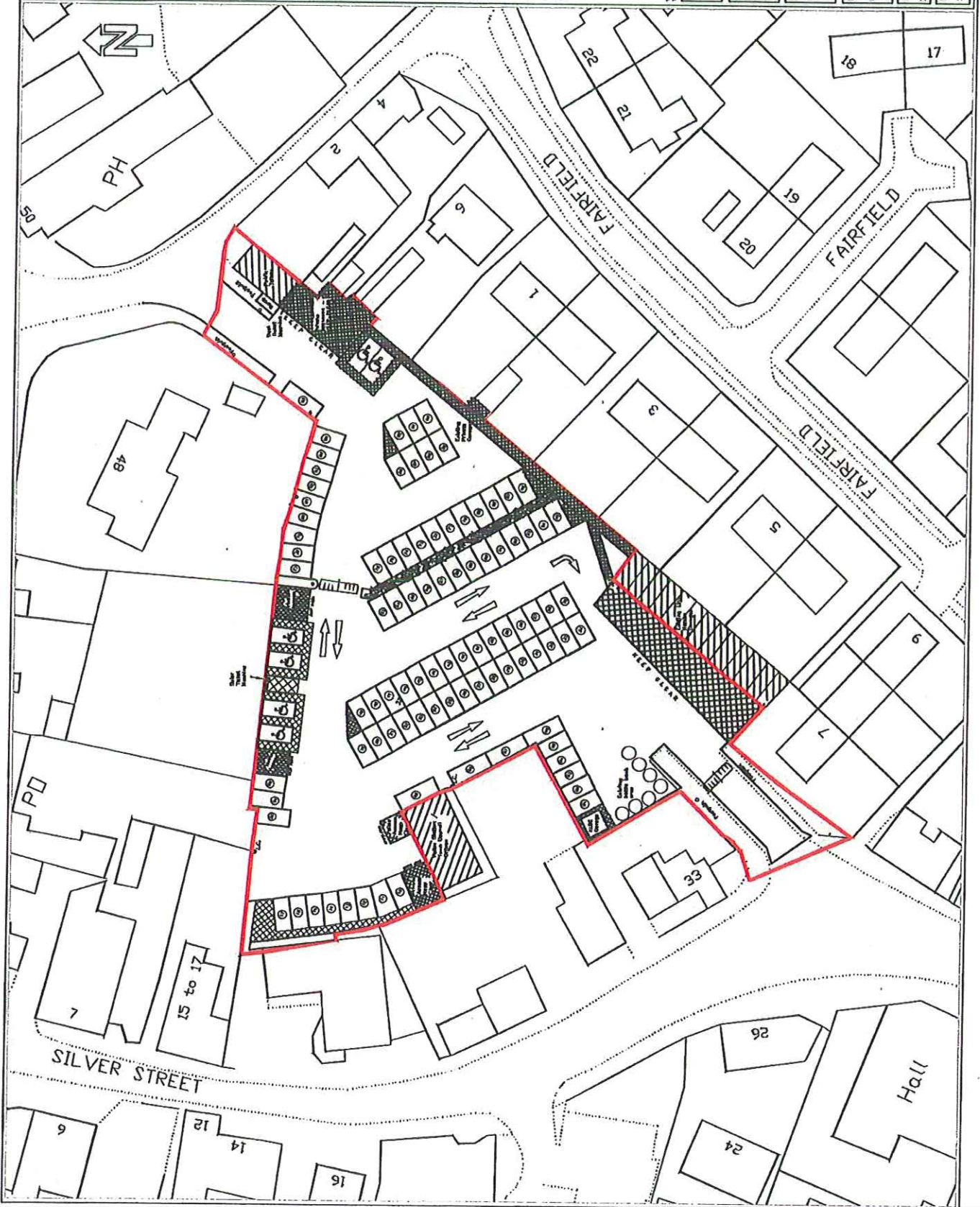

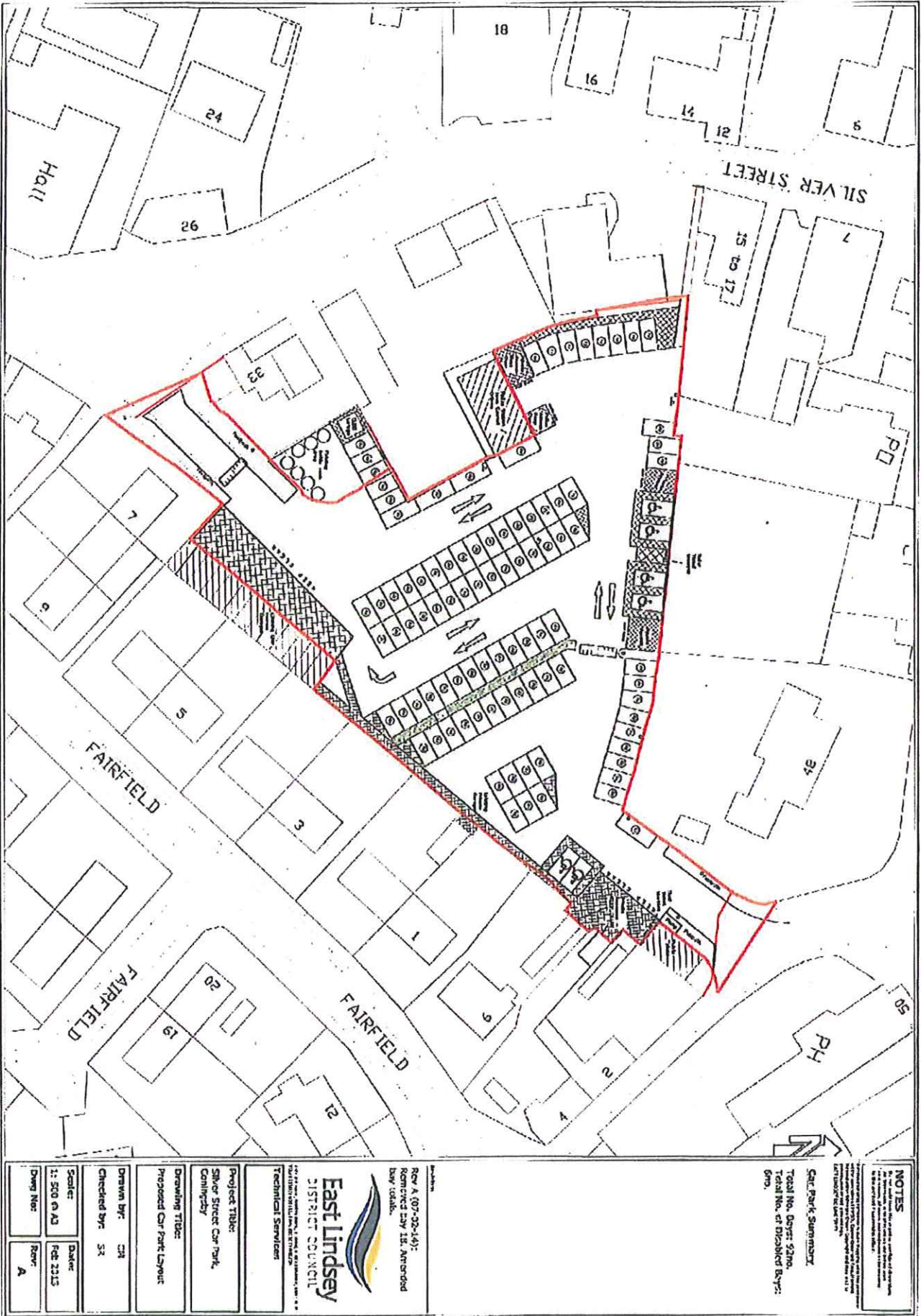

(Consolidation) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2015**

NOTICE is hereby given that East Lindsey District Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, has made the East Lindsey District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Consolidation) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2015 ("the Amending Order").

Coming into force – The Amending Order will come into force on 9 March 2015.

Nature and effect of the Amending Order - The effect of the Amending Order is to amend the East Lindsey District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Consolidation Order) 2014 by:

- introducing new 2.05 metre height restrictions on all vehicles (including unpowered vehicles such as trailers and caravans) proposing to use the Skegness car parks at North End, Princes Parade, Pierside, Festival, Swimming Pool, and Scarborough Avenue; and
- amending the areas of land identified as Princes Parade, Skegness and High Street/Silver Street, Coningsby within the off-street car parking order; and
- amending the fees and charges at the following 4 car parks to allow for a period of free parking in line with other towns within the vicinity:-
