

PARK RULES FOR SEAHAVEN SPRINGS

Preface

In these rules:

- “occupier” means anyone who occupies a park home, whether under an Agreement to which the Mobile Homes Act 1983 applies or under a tenancy or any other agreement
- “you” and “your” refers to the homeowner or other occupier of a park home
- “we” and “our” refers to the park owner

These rules are in place to ensure acceptable standards are maintained on the park, which will be of general benefit to occupiers, and to promote and maintain community cohesion. They form part of the Agreement by which homeowners occupy the pitch in accordance with the Mobile Homes Act 1983, as amended.

With one exception the rules apply to any occupiers of park homes who rent their homes.

The only rule which does not apply to occupiers who rent their homes is rule 30 about the colour of the exterior of the home, as someone renting their home would not be responsible for exterior maintenance.

None of these rules is to have retrospective effect. Accordingly: they are to apply only from the date on which they take effect, which is 5th September 2014; and no occupier who is in occupation on that date will be treated as being in breach due to circumstances which were in existence on that date and which would not have been a breach of the rules in existence before that date.

These rules also apply (for so long as they live on the park) to the park owner and any employees, with the exception of the following rules:

Rule 11; in so far as the work is related to working for Springs Estates (Lincolnshire) Ltd.

Rule 19

Rules 22, 23, and 24; in so far as the vehicles are related to working for Springs Estates (Lincolnshire) Ltd

Condition of the Pitch

1. For reasons of ventilation and safety you must keep the underneath of your home clear and not use it as a storage space.
2. You must not erect fences or other means of enclosure unless they are resistance to fire spread and certified as such, are no more than 1.8m high and you have obtained our approval (which will not be unreasonably withheld). You must position fences and any other

means of enclosure so as to comply with the parks site licence conditions and fire safety requirements.

3. You must not have external fires, including incinerators.

4. You must not keep inflammable substances on the park except in quantities reasonable for domestic use.

5. You must not keep explosive substances on the park.

Storage

6. You must not have more than one shed on the pitch. Where you source the shed yourself the design, standard and size of the shed must be approved by us in writing (approval will not be unreasonably withheld). You must position the shed so as to comply with the parks site licence and fire safety requirements. The footprint of the shed shall not exceed 4.2m² nor be more than 2.1m in height.

7. You must not have any storage receptacle on the pitch other than the shed mentioned in rule 6.

8. You must ensure that any structure erected in the separation space between park homes is of a non-combustible construction and positioned so as to comply with the parks site licence conditions and fire safety requirements.

Refuse

9. You are responsible for the disposal of all household, recyclable and garden waste in approved containers through the local authority service. You must not overfill containers and must place them in the approved position for the local authority collections.

10. You must not deposit any waste, be it household, recyclable or garden, or unroadworthy vehicles on any part of the park (including any individual pitch).

Business Activities

11. You must not use the park home, the pitch or the park (or any part of the park) for any business purpose, and you must not use the park home or the pitch for the storage of stock, plant, machinery or equipment used or last used for business purpose. However you are at liberty to work individually from home by carrying out any office work of a type which does not create a nuisance to other occupiers and does not involve other staff, other workers, customers or members of the public calling at the park home or the park.

Age of Occupants

12. No person under the age of 50 years may reside in a park home, with the exception of the park warden and their family.

Noise Nuisance

13. You must not use musical instruments, all forms of recorded music players, radios and or similar appliances and motor vehicles so as to cause a nuisance to other occupiers, especially between the hours of 10.30pm and 8.00am.

Pets

14. You must not keep any pets or animals at the park home or on the pitch except those which are housed in a cage, aquarium or similar and remain at all times within your home and the following:

- Not more than 2 dog(s) (other than any of the breeds subject to the Dangerous Dogs Act 1991).
- You must keep any dog under proper control and you must not permit it to frighten other users of the park. You must keep any dog on a leash not exceeding 1m in length and must not allow it to despoil the park.
- Not more than 2 domestic cat (s). You must keep any cat under proper control and must not permit it to frighten other users of the park, or to despoil the park.

Note: The express terms of a homeowner's agreement contain an undertaking on the part of the homeowner not to allow anything which is or becomes a nuisance, inconvenience or disturbance to other occupiers at the park and this undertaking extends to the behaviour of pets and animals.

15. Nothing in rule 14 of these Park Rules prevents you from keeping an assistance dog if this is required to support your disability and Assistance Dogs UK or any successor body has issued you with an Identification Book or other appropriate evidence.

Water

16. Where water is not separately metered at the park home or separately charged you must not use hoses, except in case of fire.

17. You must only use fire point hoses in case of fire.

18. You must protect all external water pipes from potential frost damage.

Vacant Pitches

19. You must not have access to vacant pitches and must not disturb building materials and plant.

Vehicles and Parking

20. You must drive all vehicles on the park carefully and within the displayed speed limit.

21. You must not park more than 2 vehicles on the park.
22. You must not park on the grass verges.
23. You must not park anywhere except in the permitted parking spaces.
24. You must not park commercial vehicles of any sort, including light commercial or light goods vehicles as described in the vehicle taxation legislation on the park with the exception of the park owner and the park warden.
25. You must hold a current driving licence and be insured to drive any vehicle on the park. You must also ensure that any vehicle you drive on the park is taxed in accordance with the requirements of law and is in a roadworthy condition.
26. Disused or unroadworthy vehicles must not be kept anywhere on the park. We reserve the right to remove any vehicle which is apparently abandoned.
27. You must not carry out the following works or repairs on the park:
 - a) Major vehicle repairs involving the dismantling of part(s) of the engine
 - b) Works which involve the removal of oil or other fuels.

Fire Precautions

28. You are recommended to have in your park home a fire extinguisher and fire blanket conforming to the relevant British/EU Standard.

Weapons

29. You must not use guns, firearms and offensive weapons (including crossbows) on the park and you must only keep them if you hold an appropriate licence.

External Decoration

30. Homeowners must maintain the outside of their park home in a clean and tidy condition. Where the exterior is repainted or recovered homeowners must use reasonable endeavours not to depart from the original exterior colour scheme.
