

East Lindsey Local Development Scheme Draft Timetable

- 1. The table sets out below a timetable for the submission of the review of the Local Plan to the Secretary of State.**
- 2. The timetable is predicated on the publication of the National Household projections in July 2020. The last publication was in July 2016 and they come out every two years. The Council wishes to analyse two sets of these publications from the 2016 set to see if there are trends forming in household formation and population growth. This is to ascertain the following;**
 - Is the formation of existing households in the coastal zone declining from the 2014 and 2016 publications?**
 - How is the coastal policy affecting the growth in households in the inland area of the District and is it affecting the in migrating population differently from the formation of existing households.**
 - What if any is the impact of the population churn of older in migrants on both the inland and coastal areas and is this increasing or decreasing.**
- 3. The Council also wishes to analyse the relationship between new house sales and second hand house sales to see if the trend in second hand house sales is continuing to rise and is this linked to population churn.**
- 4. The timetable is also predicated on the reporting mechanisms under the Council`s constitution in that any consultation on the Local Plan must be approved by both the Executive and full Council because only full Council can approve changes in policy. The Council will arrange special Council meetings to facilitate expediting the timetable but the process between discussions at the Planning Policy Committee where policy is debated and agreed for Council and a Council meeting normally takes 2 and half months.**
- 5. Overall this means that submission to the Secretary of State of the review of the Local Plan can occur in April 2022.**
