It is noted that the entirety of paragraph 32 has been deleted and replaced with text to further clarify where support will be afforded regarding windfall development in East Lindsey District.

Windfall development sites have a role to play in boosting significantly the supply of housing in East Lindsey District given the evidence that such sites have become available in the local area and will continue to provide a source of supply. St Andrew's Healthcare welcome the adoption towards a flexible approach to ensuring windfall development can come forward on sustainably located sites.

Moreover, St Andrew's Healthcare supports the insertion of the new text, which states the following:

"The towns within East Lindsey have a good level of services and facilities and additional growth through windfall development can be supported, providing sites conform to the policies in the Plan and national policy."

St Andrew's Healthcare consider the direction of windfall development to the towns of East Lindsey, particularly Alford, is the most appropriate strategy for ensuring the needs of the District are met in a sustainable manner over the plan period.

The proposed main modification is consistent with the 'eleventh principle' of paragraph 17 of the NPPF which sets out that plan-making should actively manage patterns of growth in locations which are sustainable.
