

In order to ensure that the Local Plan is sound by avoiding Policy SP19 from unduly restricting opportunities for growth within the tourism sector, the main modification proposed at paragraph 9 should be revised as follows:
"Where it is proposed to extend or redevelop an exiting site with a different occupancy period, consideration will be given to any proposed providing that the development would not increase in the number of caravans, log cabins or chalets on the site, such that the occupancy limits in this policy will be applied flexibly so that no disadvantage should result"
In accordance with the above, the proposed main modification at Clause 7 should also be revised as follows:
"except where it is proposed to extend or redevelop an existing site with a different occupancy period and no net increase or an overall reduction by an improved layout or density in the number of caravans, log cabins or chalets would result. In such cases, applications will be judged on their individual merits and the occupancy period will be applied on the whole site".
