**EAST LINDSEY SCHEDULE OF PROPOSED MAIN MODIFICATIONS (2017) CONSULTATION 5<sup>th</sup> JANUARY TO 5.30PM 16<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2018.**

This letter sets out the consultation process in regard to the East Lindsey Local Plan main modification consultation. This consultation runs from the 5<sup>th</sup> January to 5.30pm on the 16<sup>th</sup> February 2018.

East Lindsey District Council's Local Plan (the Plan) was submitted to the Secretary of State for independent examination on the 18<sup>th</sup> April 2017. Planning Inspectors Jeremy Youle BA (HONS) MA MRTPI and Louise Phillips MA MSc MRTPI were appointed to undertake the examination with the public hearing sessions held between the 12<sup>th</sup> July and the 4<sup>th</sup> October 2017.

As part of the examination process a number of proposed Main Modifications have been identified. A Main Modification is an amendment which is considered necessary to make the Plan sound, and is required in order to address concerns raised by either the Inspectors or other representors during the examination process.

The Council has prepared a schedule setting out the proposed Main Modifications it considers necessary in order for the Local Plan to be found sound. This document, along with a document showing proposed changes from the maps in the submission Core Strategy and Sites in the Settlement

Proposals DPD, an updated Sustainability Appraisal Report and Habitats Regulations Assessment have now been published for public consultation.

Please note that at this stage representations will only be accepted on the Proposed Main Modifications set out in the Schedule of Proposed Main Modifications to the Pre-Submission Draft Local Plan (2017) and the proposed map changes received within the consultation period. This is not an opportunity to re-state previous representations, as these have already been considered by the Inspector as part of the examination, or to raise new objections to the Pre-Submission Draft Local Plan or to seek further changes to it. For example: seeking the inclusion or omission of a site in the Plan other than those identified in the Proposed Main Modifications.

The Local Plan Examination webpage will be updated as appropriate and all those making representations will be informed of the next steps by the Programme Officer in due course.
